Memberships are slowly coming in. We have a long way to go yet. Please remember that memberships are current through June 30th along with the other clubs.

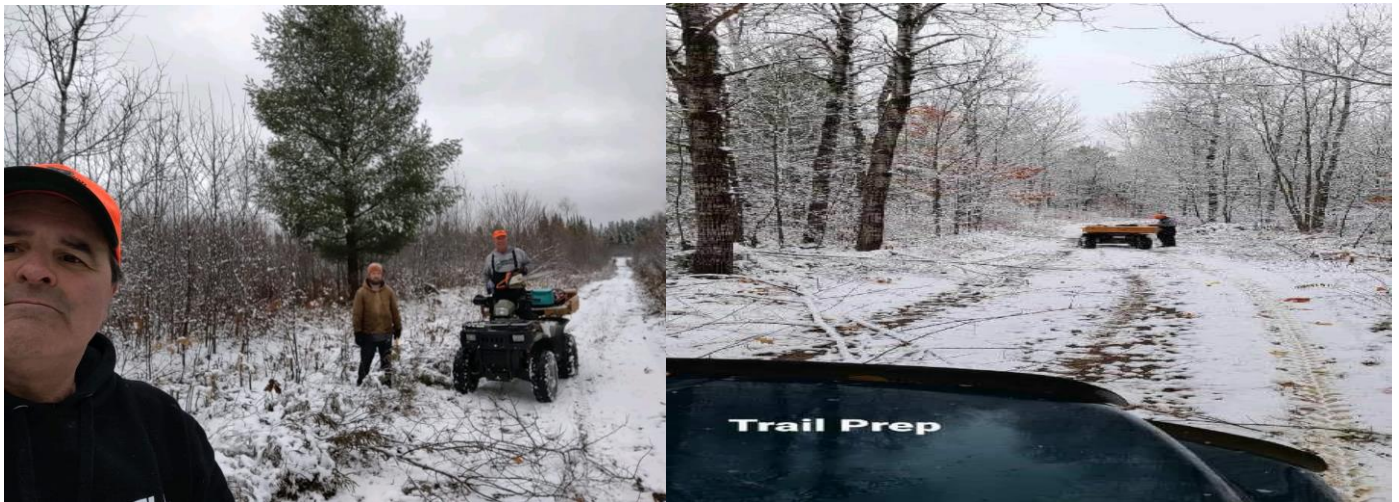
