November 18, 2025 Meeting Summary:

The Trail Boss list has been updated, and all emails have been sent to the current trail bosses. If you know of any maintenance or brushing needed, contact Todd.

Pelican River Trail 17 and Bridge work update - We are waiting on a permit and approvals from the DOT, ROW and DNR regarding water and wetlands regulations. The OC Highway department is working on installing culverts 1-7, culvert 8 will be installed late Sept. 2026 and the last culvert will be installed once the bridge is installed.

The Spider Lake Road reroute has been successfully updated.

The McNaughton trail reroute needs to have the old trail signs removed and the new signs installed.

The club is looking into the purchase of a roller (received \$5,000 grant from WPS last year). Additionally Elvis has one to donate.

There has been some confusion regarding the membership renewal process. Please note that renewal applications are not processed immediately when received. They are currently processed every couple of weeks (this will increase as we get closer to snowmobile season). Once the renewal is complete (by HST and AWSC), you will receive emails letting you know that your membership has been renewed, and you can purchase your trail passes through AWSC. You will also receive an email confirmation from the AWSC as long as you have provided your email address. Yellow membership cards will NO LONGER be mailed to members. You can download and print your membership card from the AWSC once your membership has been renewed. Current club membership rates are \$35 for a single membership and \$45 for a family.
