*The process is as follows for a reminder or for anyone that does not know:*

Member renews online (online implies instant results - this is unfortunate)

OR

Member mails application form with enclosed check to P.O. Box 621. (P.O. Box is checked several times each week)

Trails holds applications until a suitable batch (>6) has accumulated. This is AWSC's requirement, not ours.

Once HST submits the updates and \$12 fee to AWSC, their computer typically updates memberships within 24 hours thereby facilitating the purchase of trail passes. An email is then sent to the affected members at this point, although many will have already gone online and purchased their passes.

WisDNR mails the passes directly to the members, BUT you can ride with a printed copy of your DNR receipt in hand.
