RE: Snowmobile Safety Reminder

The Oneida County Forestry Department, in partnership with the Oneida County Snowmobile Council, would like to remind snowmobile enthusiasts to adhere to the following guidelines to help ensure a safe and enjoyable snowmobile experience:

- Take a Snowmobile Safety Course
- Don't Drink Alcohol and Drive
- Slow Down – 55 mph at Night
- Ride Within Your Ability & Experience
- STOP means STOP, Especially When Crossing Roadways
- Stay to the Right
- Only Pass When Appropriate & With Extreme Caution
- Respect the Groomers
- Report Trail Hazards

In case of an emergency, dial 911 and notify them of the nearest TINS (Trail Intersections Numbering System), the 3-digit number on the square brown sign located at most intersections and trail crossings. This may help emergency personnel determine your exact location and respond quicker.
